Dear Parents / Guardians,

This afternoon, Governor Whitmer signed House Bill 4206 to forgive four additional snow days that occurred while the state was under a state of emergency due to extreme cold temperatures during the 2018-19 school year. While the Michigan Department of Education still has to develop a new waiver process for schools to apply for the additional forgiveness days, we can now plan to make adjustments to our 2018-19 school calendar.

Kearsley will no longer be adding additional days as had been communicated back in February and will be returning to our original school calendar. **The last day for students will be on Thursday, June 6, 2019.** That day will be a half day of school for grades K-8 and the third and final exam day at the high school.
